## Non-Credit Course Descriptions

**Billiard Basics** Learn the origin and history of pool. Students will discover the rules of play, the importance of stance and balance, and find out how your body should be aligned. Learn about stroke mechanics, force follow, throw shots, deflection & its control and much more. At the end of class a tournament style match will be played by all billiard students. Bring your own cue or purchase from the instructor for approximately \$50. Additional classes may be scheduled based on interest of enrolled students.

**Cake Decorating for Beginners** Step into the RLC Culinary Kitchen as you learn the best way to bake a cake and make icing. Our instructor will show you tips on decorating. She'll even let you use her icing tip and tools so you can try before you buy. Students bring a cake to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> sessions. \$10 supply fee is payable to instructor for bags, tips, and icing.

**Cake Decorating Beyond The Basics** Already know the basics and ready to learn something new? This course will cover more difficult flowers and techniques. Our instructor will show you how to work with cutting cakes to make shapes, perfect for the Easter holiday. Students bring their own cakes to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> sessions. A \$10 supply fee is payable to the instructor for bags, tips, and icing.

**Digital Photography SLR Cameras** Learn how to use your digital camera and experience the enjoyment of producing quality photographs. Professional photographers will help you become familiar with your camera and settings, better understand lighting conditions, and gain insight on elements of good photo composition. Bring camera and manual to class.

**Hunter Safety** Participation in this class is a requirement in state statute for hunters born on or after January 1, 1980, when applying for a hunting license. Course includes: wildlife management, firearms safety, hunter ethics, game identification, first aid, survival techniques and regulations. Pre-registration is required due to limited enrollment. Bring both a pen and pencil to both sessions.

**Lebanon Tour *History and Hauntings*** Join us as we take a historic and frightening tour through one of Southern Illinois' most beautiful, and haunted, small towns. Lebanon was founded in 1804 but the culture dates back further. Charles Dickens, during his travels in America, stopped in Lebanon in 1842 while visiting the Looking Glass Prairie. The Mermaid Inn, built in 1830, served as his stopover point on his journey west. Lebanon's Main Street stands alone as a ghost hunters' paradise. From mysterious underground tunnels to phone calls from the beyond, you'll jump between the present and the past, the living and the dead with this chilling tour led by our guide and historian, Len Adams. The Haunted Lebanon tour is a 2-hour walking tour and spine tingling journey into the haunted history of Lebanon. It's an easy walk with stops along the way. Registration fee is \$70 after February 26<sup>th</sup>. *No refunds issued for tour cancellations less than two-weeks prior to departure date.*

**Me & My Buddy Mystery Dinner Theater** Do you love solving mysteries? Have fun helping us discover "whodunit" during our Mystery Dinner Party for kids and adult buddies. Use your detective skills to search through clues and solve the mystery. Will you be the one who figures it out first? This is a non-murder mystery suitable for children. Dinner is included.

**Mystery Dinner Theater *Slay It Again Sam*** This adult-themed murder mystery will have you sleuthing for clues. Professional actor/writer Kevin

O'Brien will host the evening. The show is very fast-paced and funny, half scripted and half improvised. As guests arrive, they are assigned a new identity for the evening. Some may even become suspects. Can you figure out who did it? Dinner is included in the registration fee.

**Small Engine Repair** Get your lawn mower ready for spring! Take care of those small repairs and maintenance service yourself. This class will teach you basic repair and replacement of gasoline and engine parts, cooling, tune-up, lubricating, electrical components, starting systems and engine overhaul.

**Stairway to Success Conference** Whether you are looking for help with personal or professional relationships, this workshop, "Effective Communication Brings Superior Results," will meet your needs. Learn more about how you may unknowingly be sabotaging your communication with others. Communication approach, quality, body language, planning, and leading effective meetings will be covered in this workshop. Presenter, Teresa Gilbert, is an extraordinarily talented trainer and facilitator who has the unique ability to translate complex situations into easily understandable and manageable concepts. You are sure to walk away with information to make your personal and professional life better. Lunch is included in registration fee that is due February 11. Late registration fee is \$95.

**Taxidermy** Learn the art of preserving, mounting and displaying animal skins. Get hands-on experience by mounting your own bird, fish, deer or small animal. Supplies for class include species to mount (needs to be thawed) and scalpel or sharp knife. Added costs for other supplies will be determined by your selected project. A projected supply list will be mailed to you at the time of registration. Instructor will discuss in further detail on the first night of class. Class size limited to the first 12 paid students.
