Non-Credit Course Descriptions

Airplanes for Non-Pilots Explore the world of aviation through the basics of airplanes, airplane systems and instruments. You will learn the responsibilities of a pilot in this evening of discovery. The requirements and regulations of becoming a pilot will also be discussed.

Aromatherapy for Health & Happiness

This basic aromatherapy course will teach you safety and how to effectively use essential oils every day. You will learn how oils can be used to enhance health and happiness, applications to relieve common ailments, and make products to treat the skin and enhance the quality of your spirit. Supply fee of \$65, payable to instructor, includes book and oil kit. Students will receive 1 credit hour upon successful completion of this course.

Easy Being Green

Learn how to save energy, money and the environment. This course will provide background information on consumer habits as they relate to energy consumption and their impact on the environment. Energy systems, both traditional and alternative, transportation, agriculture, home heating/cooling, pre-cycling/recycling, and 'Green Home-Ec' will be discussed. Instructor will offer suggestions to gradually adjust common behaviors to become more environmentally-friendly in everyday life. You will have a better idea of the individual and collective impact on the environment and how you can save money by being 'green.'

Hospice Volunteer Certification Training Hospice needs volunteers in all Southern Illinois counties. Topics include patient/family care, diseases and conditions, role of the volunteer, communication skills, resources, community awareness. Earn 1 credit hour upon successful completion.

Hunter Safety Participation in this class is a requirement in state statute for hunters born on or after January 1, 1980, when applying for a hunting license. Course includes: wildlife management, firearms safety, hunter ethics, game identification, first aid, survival techniques and regulations. **PARTICIPANTS MUST PROVIDE DATE OF BIRTH WHEN REGISTERING. Bring a pen and pencil to both sessions.**
