### Non-Credit Course Descriptions

**Food Crafts** Hey kids—come be creative in the kitchen! You will learn kitchen basics while creating a fun craft using edible art supplies. Most of the ingredients are common household items and will be used to make play dough, clay and paint. You will take home the finished product and recipes for future use. Must be in first grade or older. Supply fee of \$3.

**Hunter Safety** Participation in this class is a requirement in state statute for hunters born on or after January 1, 1980, when applying for a hunting license. Course includes: wildlife management, firearms safety, hunter ethics, game identification, first aid, survival techniques and regulations.

PARTICIPANTS MUST PROVIDE THEIR DATE OF BIRTH WHEN REGISTERING. Pre-registration is required due to limited enrollment. Bring both a pen and pencil to both sessions.
